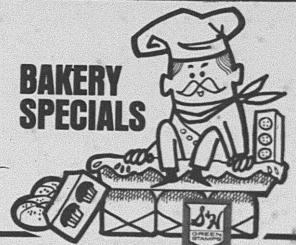

June 24 Opening Date For Teal Hunting Permits

Free hunting permits for Michigan's experimental September 15 - 23 teal season will be available starting June 24 to a maximum of 15,000 sportsmen through applications to the Conservation Department's Lansing office.

The Department, which will issue the special federal permits on a first-come first-served basis, is asking for applications only from hunters who are razor-sharp in identifying ducks.

WHY?

It is urging all others to bypass the early teal season in hopes of reversing last fall's disturbing trend in which a large percentage of hunters fired at protected birds, either because they didn't know their ducks or out of carelessness.

Explains Department waterfowl specialist Edward Mikula: "This fall's hunt is the third and final one under a three-year experiment to see how teal stand up to extra hunting and to test sportsmen for their selective shooting. It is keyed to hunters picking out the right birds only. If they can't, they may well forfeit the chance to have this bonus season established on a regular management basis."

This fall's test hunt will allow sportsmen with permits, 1967 small game licenses, and federal "duck" stamps to shoot teal in any of eight special areas during the nine-day season.

Permits for the season will be issued by the Department according to the dates they are postmarked between June 24 and the July 31 cut-off.

If more than 15,000 applications reach the Department postmarked June 24, a random machine drawing will be held to select the successful ones.

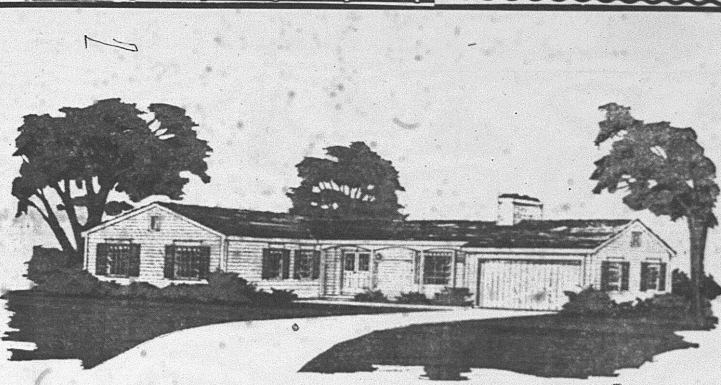

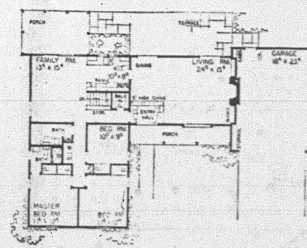
